What TIA courses can be used for GI Bill benefit reimbursement?

As of July 2024, the two courses that can be submitted for reimbursement to the Department of Veterans Affairs are the <u>Certified Transportation Broker (CTB)</u> program and the <u>New Broker Certification (NBC)</u> program. For more information on the course schedules, policies, and syllabus, please visit the links for each course above.



How much can be reimbursed?

For the **CTB program**, students can be reimbursed for the cost of exams only per trimester. Due to the CTB exam structure, students have multiple attempts to pass the exam.

If a student is enrolled in a CTB exam section, they are eligible for reimbursement. CTB exams cost \$150 per section, and CTB students can be reimbursed by the Department of Veterans Affairs for up to \$450.

For the **NBC program**, students can be reimbursed for the cost of the course and the exam up to \$995 per quarter.

What is the process for reimbursement?

Following enrollment in either the CTB or NBC programs, students will need to complete <u>VA</u> <u>form 22-10272</u> and return that form to the Department of Veterans Affairs for reimbursement. Students will need to use <u>facility code 46006546</u> on the form to receive the proper reimbursement.

Do I need to be a member of TIA to take the NBC and CTB courses?
